

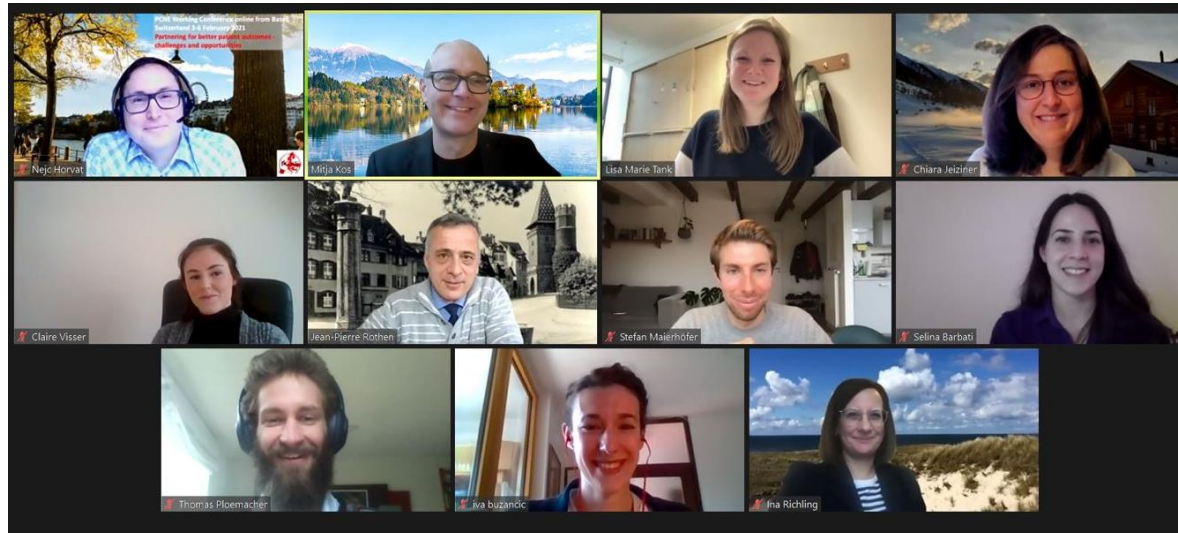
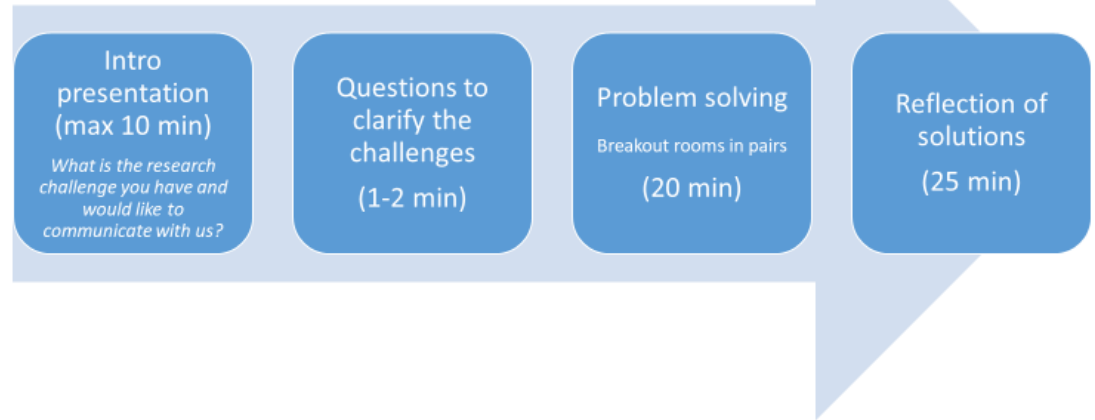

- ▶ How to access data?

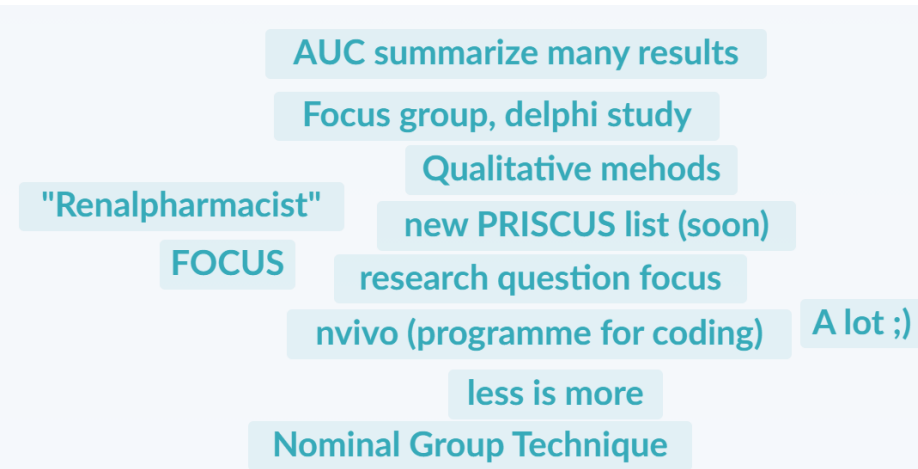


Methods

- ▶ RCT for benefits of services

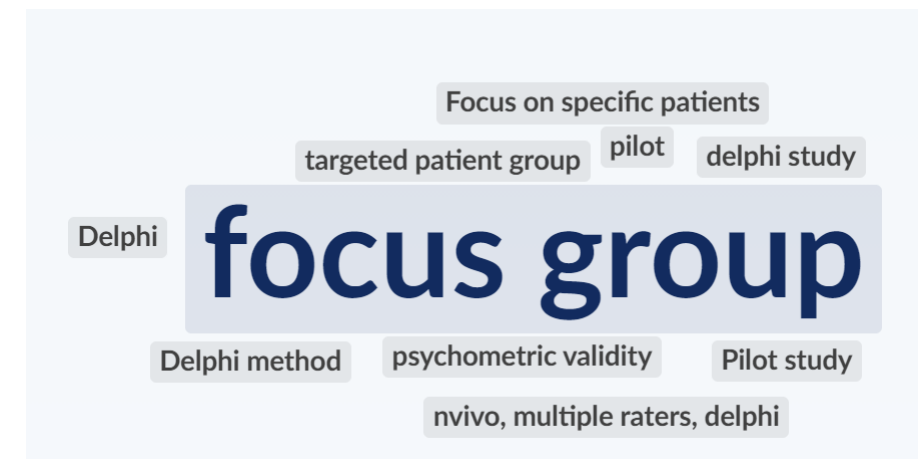
What content from the workshop was new to you?

 - Delphi study



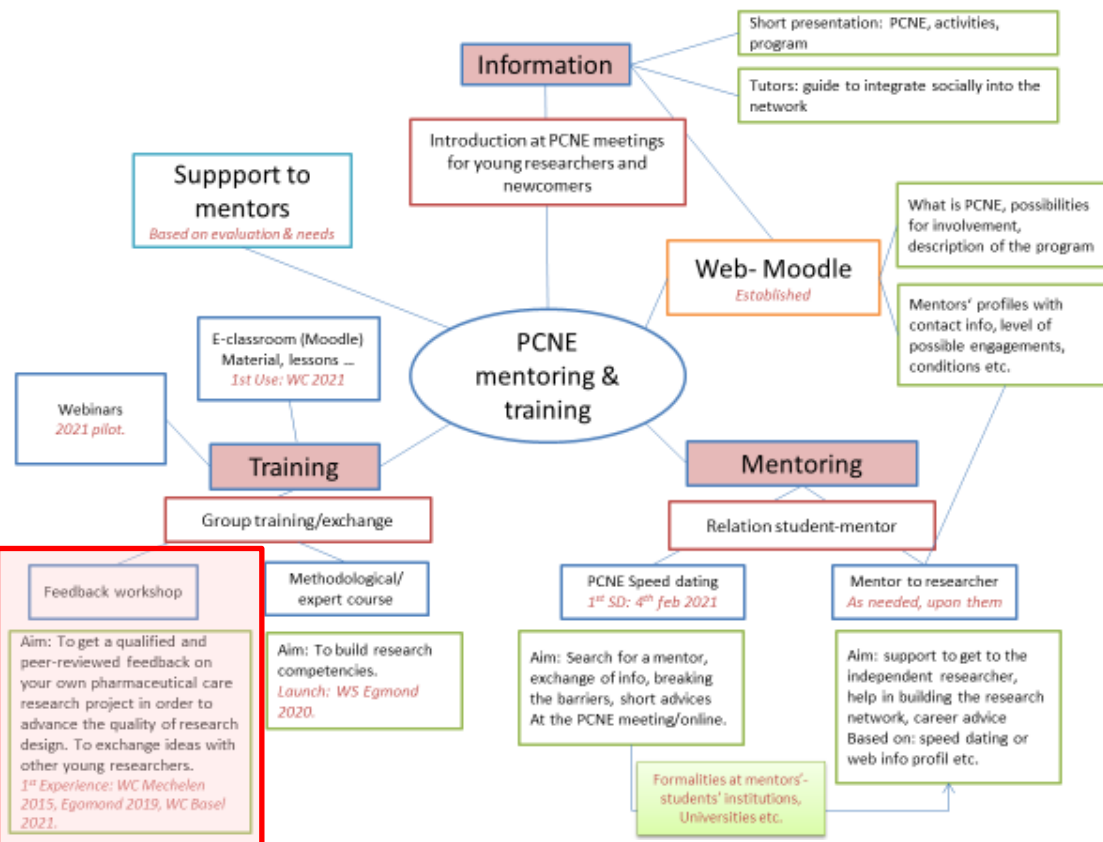
What content (study design, methods, solutions, approaches ...) would you consider in the future?
