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# Main recommendations

- Need of investment in education of all parties (citizens – patients/caregivers, practitioners and researchers);
- Need of investment in interprofessional collaboration;
- Patient communication, common software and funding for partnership should be explored;
- A standard of practice and education on digital health, as well as a quality management system should be set;
- EU projects should be explored for common software for patient communication
- Separate into different sectors barriers & facilitators and list according to the main stakeholders (patients, HCP's, government, etc), avoiding overlap.
